A Word, Sentence And Texts Are Composed Of Straight Lines, Curves And Circles. Curves Can Be Changed To A Straight Line. Similarly, Circles Can Be Cut Opened And Changed Into Straight Lines. The Straight Lines Can Be Of Two Types. One In The Clockwise, And The Other In The Anticlockwise Direction.

If We Obtain The Vector Sum Of All The Straight Lines Composing A Text, Then We Will Get A Specific Length Oriented Into A Clockwise Or Anticlockwise Direction, Which Will Be Unique For That Text. Similar Result Can Be Obtained For A Word Or A Letter.

So We Can Compare, Letters, Words And Texts For Their Inherent Length And Orientation With Respect To Clockwise Or Anticlockwise Direction.

This Method Can Be Very Useful In Deciphering A Script.
