## **Post Covid Encephalitis with post infectious polyneuropathy (GBS): a rare clinical presentation**

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## Abstract:

A case of a 16 years old boy, who presented with multiple episodes of vomiting, sore throat and difficulty in swallowing. Within 2 days of initial presentation he was comatose and following was intubated. His SARS-CoV 2 IgG antibody report came positive and CSF analysis showed albumin-cytological dissociation. The patient recovered with intravenous methylprednisolone and intravenousimmunoglobulin therapy, which was given for 5 days. Non- specific GI symtoms could be an initial symptom of post covid encephalitis and these patients may require immunosuppressive therapy.

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**Conclusion:** The objective of this communication is to call attention to the practical importance of knowledge of rare presentation of SARS-CoV 2 infection.
